

Recognition: A patch for each Scout and Scouter

Requirements

- 1. To qualify, a Scout or Scouter must have camped <u>outdoors</u> in *January, February, November, and December of the <u>same</u> calendar year*. It is the Troop's responsibility to keep accurate records of each participant at each campout during the year so that the earning of this award can be proved. Each Scout or Scouter (adult) must be at the campout from its departure until its return.
- 2. Lockins which count for the 12 Month Camping Award do not count for this award.
- 3. The Troop must turn in this form which lists the qualifying people by December 31 to the Council Service Center with their recharter. It is the Troop's responsibility to keep accurate records from which the earning of this award can be proved. The District Chair of Camping and Outdoor Activities will pick up this completed form and review it for approval. A copy of the Troop's 12 month record of campout participants would be helpful. After the approval, the Scoutmaster will be informed of the number of patches the troop may purchase. Only one patch per person may be earned during each calendar year, but the patch may be earned for as many years as desired or possible.
- 4. This patch is <u>not for sale to anyone other than the Scouts or Scouters who have earned it.</u> All earned patches must be purchased at the same time by an adult representative of the troop.
- 5. A replacement patch <u>may not</u> be purchased. A Scout or Scouter must meet the requirements again to receive another patch.
